Neighborhood Traffic Management Program Request Form

The **City of Houston Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP)** is taking action to address traffic issues through out the community. The goal of the **NTMP** is to improve neighborhood quality of life by implementing traffic calming techniques and effective engineering principles to reduce cut-through traffic, reduce excessive vehicular speed, and improve safety of drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

The **NTMP** request forms are received continuously, and application are placed in a waiting list in the order received and completed. Application request forms are reviewed by the department to determine eligibility and prioritized for further consideration. The review is based on the criteria contained in Section 45-365 of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances. The department evaluates the information submitted and select project for planning in the next fiscal year. Once a neighborhood is selected, all residents of the neighborhood will be invited to the first public meeting. Interested residents can volunteer to participate in the Neighborhood Traffic Committee, where members of the committee will be selected at the first public meeting.
